

ECONOMIC THOUGHT AND POLITICAL ECONOMY A NOTE ON SOURCES

Preliminarily we can understand the study of ECONOMIC THOUGHT as a diachronical study of the literature, written sources, concerning economy and economic life. In this broad sense it exists everywhere since the beginning of History. To make it operational we must narrow the sense of this area of intellectual endeavour.

More specifically, it can be understood as the study of the significant texts by economists, including representative texts of all of the major thinkers and schools of thought; and most of the sub-fields of economics.

On the basis of such a definition Professor Rod Ray organized one of the most extensive databases of works by economists in existence today, with texts posted "primarily for the use of students who might not otherwise have access to these writings." Works by Charles Babbage, William Blake, Adam Ferguson, and David Hume, to name but a few, are included at the site, which will continue to be maintained at McMaster.

The following list includes a large number of authors read in the Anglo-Saxon World. It does not include most of the economists who wrote in French, Spanish, Italian, Russian, Portuguese, Japanese or German. To study world economic thought is necessarily a multilanguage enterprise.
